RESOLUTION REQUESTING RAMSEY COUNTY TO CHANGE SPEED LIMIT ON FAIRVIEW AVENUE BETWEEN ROSELAWN AVENUE AND LARPENTEUR AVENUE

WHEREAS, Fairview Avenue between Roselawn Avenue to Larpenteur Avenue is a County State Aid roadway;

WHEREAS, such roadway is under Ramsey County jurisdiction and maintained by Ramsey County Public Works;

WHEREAS, the speed limit on Fairview Avenue between Roselawn Avenue and Larpenteur Avenue is posted at 40MPH;

WHEREAS, Falcon Heights is establishing bicycle lanes on Fairview Avenue between Roselawn Avenue and Larpenteur Avenue;

WHEREAS, Minnesota State Statute 160.263 Subd 4. Allows the governing body of any political subdivision, by resolution and without an engineering or traffic investigation, to designate a safe speed for any street or highway under its authority upon which it has established a bicycle lane;

AND WHEREAS, the city requests that Ramsey County designate the speed limit on Fairview Avenue between Roselawn Avenue and Larpenteur Avenue at 35 MPH.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Falcon Heights, Minnesota that the City of Falcon Heights requests Ramsey County designate the speed limit on Fairview Avenue between Roselawn Avenue and Larpenteur Avenue at 35 MPH;
