- 1) Discussion relating to a multi-year Police partnership/contract with St. Anthony.**

Council directed staff to explore this option with specific re-openers that would require the parties to come back to the table if costs became too excessive.

Council directed staff to pursue an agreement with the SPPA for implementation and administration of a PACE program in the City.
