RESOLUTION ORDERING THE PREPARATION OF A FEASIBILITY REPORT FOR
THE 2015 PAVEMENT MANAGEMENT PROGRAM

WHEREAS, it is proposed to improve the following streets and alleys:

- Roselawn Avenue, from Snelling Avenue to Fairview Avenue
- East Snelling Service Drive, from Roselawn Avenue to Crawford Avenue
- West Snelling Service Drive, from Roselawn Avenue to BP gas station
- Garden Avenue, from Snelling Avenue to Albert Street

and to assess the benefited property for all or a portion of the cost of the improvement, pursuant to Minnesota Statutes, Chapter 429,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Falcon Heights, Minnesota:

That the proposed improvement be referred to as the 2015 Pavement Management Program for study and that the City Engineer is instructed to report to the council with all convenient speed advising the council in a preliminary way as to whether the proposed improvement is necessary, cost-effective, and feasible and as to whether it should best be made as proposed or in connection with some other improvement, the estimated cost of the improvement as recommended, and a description of the methodology used to calculate individual assessments for affected parcels.
