## RESOLUTION APPROVING THE TRAFFIC CONTROL SIGNAL AGREEMENT MnDOT CONTRACT NO: 1032118 FOR THE SNELLING AVENUE & HOYT AVENUE SIGNAL

WHEREAS, the Minnesota Department of Transportation has identified the need to replace the traffic signal at the intersection of Snelling Avenue (Trunk Highway 51) and Hoyt Avenue; and,

WHEREAS, Snelling Avenue is owned by the State of Minnesota Department of Transportation, the north legs of Hoyt Avenue are owned by the City of Falcon Heights, the south side of the east leg of Hoyt Avenue is owned by the City of St Paul and where the south side of the east leg is owned by the Minnesota State Agricultural Society; and,
