# Jesse Freihammer, City Engineer

Change Order #3 is for some additional work done on Albert Street. The actual amount was around \$20,900. The change in cost is lower than the amount included in the packet. Change Order #4 accounts for additional work to remove a buried concrete footing near St Mary's St. and Larpenteur Ave. The amount was \$5,862.82.

Pay Estimate #4 is in the amount of \$427,342.88 and includes aggregate base installation and pavement milling and overlay. We are hoping to complete restoration of turf a little later to allow the weather to be cooler.

In August 1985, Falcon Heights and the Ramsey County Redevelopment Authority entered into a Joint Cooperative Agreement. The amendment must be adopted in order to qualify for the next three years. We are not large enough to receive block grants directly, so the City applies for block grant funds through the County. Staff would recommend approval of the resolution and authorize the City Administrator and the Mayor to execute all necessary documents as it relates to the agreement.

# Administrator Thongvanh

The City is funded by a number of different mechanisms including the levy, fiscal disparities, and local government aid, as well as revenues from permits and licensing. We are expecting a 5% decrease in fiscal disparities for 2022.

We did receive half of our American Recovery funds, we are expected to receive more in the future. This will be a topic for a future workshop. The City is trying to be less reliant on Local Government Aid, and using any aid received through LGA for capital projects rather than supplementing the general fund. The City applies revenues from Cable TV franchise fees to technology needs for the AV system, and 25% would be moved to the general capital fund.

There is an error in the PERA contributions for legislative expenditures, it should be \$1,000, not \$21,000.

For staff salaries, I have modified the percentage coming from various funds to cover administrative salaries. This is why the proposed 2022 appears lower in administrative expenditures.

The increased IT costs in communications is partly related to the shifting of the demand for services from the fire department back to the general operations.

The City no longer has a part time emergency management staff person. Now Ramsey County is my backup.

Is the emergency preparedness training still being offered?

# Administrator Thongvanh

I'm in contact with the County, we can look into that in the future.

I have been in communication with Saint Paul about providing police services to the city. Saint Paul has said they need more time to plan for taking on additional demands for services. We are looking at a one-year contract with Ramsey County, and I believe Little Canada and some of the other contract cities are as well. The decrease in the budget for 2022 is actually because of the backup that RCSO will be providing to the State Fair. If Falcon Heights pulled out, other cities have said that their costs would increase significantly.

The Fire Service contract is shown under fire services expenditures and this will remain the only item in that fund after the disbanding of the fire department in 2021.

Falcon Woods pavement will be a full reconstruction when that project comes around, and Garden Avenue may be also.

Fund 134 is the Tree Program Expenditures. In the last few years, we moved tree services out of the capital fund into the general fund so we can be transparent in the budgeting for it. The council will need to think about the City's philosophy around trees. Many other communities do not put trees in the boulevard to avoid the city's responsibility for maintaining the tree in the future.

Park Maintenance and Administration Expenditures shows a transfer out in the amount of \$26,000 to supplement park programming cost. This is a service that the City has identified as one that does not represent a net positive, but is still an important one to provide. The warming house is still in the budget for 2022.

The sale of the fire trucks will allow funds to cover outstanding debt on the equipment when the bonds are callable. The remainder of the funds would be put into a capital fund for the Council to decide how to spend.

We still have a few more budget items to discuss but those will be covered at the next council workshop. I am hoping we can hold the levy to 5-7%, and other cities in Ramsey County are ranging from 4-7%.

- document more evergreen as membership changes. This change was also done in section 6 and 8.
- Section V.8 "Unless otherwise required herein, all official actions of the Commission must receive
- two-thirds (2/3) of all the authorized votes cast on that issue at a duly constituted meeting of the
- 13 Commission and the affirmative vote of a majority of the appointed directors present and voting.
- Abstentions shall not be considered authorized votes cast.

# AMENDED NORTH SUBURBAN COMMUNICATIONS COMMISSION JOINT AND COOPERATIVE AGREEMENT FOR THE ADMINISTRATION OF A CABLE COMMUNICATIONS FRANCHISES

# I. PARTIES

The parties to this Agreement are governmental units of the state of Minnesota. This Agreement is made pursuant to Minnesota statutes Section 471.59, as amended.

# II. GENERAL PURPOSE

The general purpose of this Agreement is to establish an organization to administer and enforce the respective cable franchises of the parties; to administer the procedure for the renewal of the existing cable franchises and the procedure for the award of new cable franchises; to promote, coordinate, administer and develop <u>public</u>, <u>educational</u>, <u>and governmental</u> (PEG) access cable television channels and <u>local community media</u>, including <u>cable television</u> programming; and to conduct such other activities authorized herein as may be necessary to establish and enforce consumer protection standards for cable subscribers of the members of the organization.

#### III. NAME

The name of the organization is the North Suburban Communications Commission (NSCC).

#### IV. DEFINITION OF TERMS

- **Section 1**. For the purposes of this Agreement, the terms defined in this Article shall have the meanings given to them.
- **Section 2**. "Commission" means the Board of Directors created pursuant to this Agreement.
  - **Section 3**. "Council" means the governing body of a member.
- **Section 4**. "Franchise" means that cable communications franchise granted by all cities listed in Article V, section 1.
- **Section 5**. "Grantee" means any person or entity to whom a franchise has been granted by a member.
  - **Section 6**. "Member" means a municipality which enters into this Agreement.
- **Section 7**. "System" means that cable communications system more specifically defined in the Franchise Ordinance of the Member.

#### V. MEMBERSHIP

- **Section 1**. The municipalities of Arden Hills, Falcon Heights, Little Canada, Lauderdale, Moundsview, New Brighton, North Oaks, Roseville, and St. Anthony are eligible to be the Members of the Commission. Any municipality geographically contiguous to any of these named municipalities and served by a cable communications system through the same Grantee may become a Member pursuant to the terms of this Agreement.
- **Section 2**. Any municipality desiring to become a Member shall execute a copy of this Agreement and conform to all requirements herein.
- **Section 3**. The initial Members shall be those municipalities listed in Section 1 of this Article V.
- **Section 4.** Municipalities desiring to become Members after the date specified in Article V; Section 3, may be admitted by an affirmative vote of two-thirds (2/3) of the votes of the Members of the Commission, with at least a majority of the Members five (5)—Members-voting in the affirmative. The Commission may, by resolution, impose conditions upon the admission of additional members.

# VI. DIRECTORS; VOTING

- **Section 1**. Each Member shall be entitled to one (1) director to represent it on the Commission. Each director is entitled to vote in direct proportion to the percent of annual revenues attributable to the municipality represented by the director to the total annual revenues of the system for the prior year rounded to the nearest whole number, provided, however, that each director shall have at least one vote. For the purposes of this section, the annual revenues for each Member and the total annual system revenues as of December 31 of each year shall be determined by the records of the cable operator filed with the Commission with the annual franchise fee. Prior to the first Commission meeting in March of each year, the Secretary/Treasurer of the Commission shall determine the number of votes for each Member in accordance with this section and certify the results to the Chair.
- **Section 2**. A director shall be appointed by resolution of the Council of each Member. A director shall serve until a successor is appointed. Directors shall serve without compensation from the Commission.
- **Section 3**. Each Member may appoint an alternate director or directors. The Commission, in its By-Laws, may prescribe the extent of an alternate's powers and duties.
- **Section 4**. A vacancy in the office of director will exist for any of the reasons set forth in Minnesota Statutes Section 351.02 or upon a revocation of a director's appointment duly filed by a Member with the Commission. Vacancies shall be filled by appointment for the unexpired portion of the term of director by the Council of the Member whose position on the Commission is vacant.

- **Section 5**. There shall be no voting by proxy, but all votes must be cast by the director or the duly authorized alternate at a Commission meeting.
- **Section 6**. The presence of <u>five a majority of the appointed</u> directors representing a majority of the total authorized votes of all directors shall constitute a quorum, but a smaller number may adjourn from time to time.
- **Section 7**. A director shall not be eligible to vote on behalf of the director's municipality during the time said municipality is in default on any contribution or payment to the Commission. During the existence of such default, the vote or votes of such Member shall not be counted for the purposes of this Agreement.
- **Section 8**. All official actions of the Commission must receive two-thirds (2/3) of all authorized votes cast on that issue at a duly constituted meeting of the Commission and the affirmative vote of five a majority of the appointed directors. Abstentions shall not be considered authorized votes cast.

#### VII. EFFECTIVE DATE

- **Section 1**. A municipality may enter into this Agreement by resolution of its council and the duly authorized execution of a copy of this Agreement by its proper officers. Thereupon, the clerk or other appropriate officer of the municipality shall file a duly executed copy of this Agreement, together with a certified copy of the authorizing resolution, with the Commission.
- **Section 2**. This Agreement and any amendments thereto are effective on the date when executed agreements and authorizing resolutions of all of the members named in Article V, Section 1, have been filed as provided in this Article.

#### VIII. POWERS AND DUTIES OF THE COMMISSION

- **Section 1**. The powers and duties of the Commission shall include the powers set forth in this Article.
- **Section 2**. The Commission may make such contracts, grants, and take such other action as it deems necessary and appropriate to accomplish the general purposes of the organization. The Commission may not contract for the purchase of real estate without the prior authorization of the member municipalities. Any purchases or contracts made shall conform to the requirements applicable to Minnesota statutory cities.
- **Section 3**. The Commission shall assume all authority and undertake all tasks necessary to coordinate, administer, and enforce the Franchise of each Member except for that authority and those tasks specifically retained by a Member.
  - **Section 4.** The Commission may provide for the prosecution, defense, or other

participation in actions or proceedings at law in which it may have an interest, and may employ counsel for that purpose. It may employ such other persons as it deems necessary to accomplish its powers and duties. Such employees may be on a full time, part-time or consulting basis, as the Commission determines, and the Commission may make any required employer contributions which local governmental units are authorized or required to make by law.

- **Section 5**. The Commission may conduct such research and investigation and take such action as it deems necessary including participation and appearance in proceedings of State and Federal regulatory, legislative or administrative bodies, or on any matter related to or affecting cable communication franchises.
- **Section 6**. The Commission may obtain from Grantee and from any other source such information relating to the cable communications franchises as any member is entitled to obtain from Grantee or others.
- **Section 7**. The Commission may accept gifts, apply for and use grants, enter into agreements required in connection therewith and hold, use and dispose of money or property received as a gift or grant in accordance with the terms thereof.
- **Section 8**. The Commission shall make an annual, independent audit of the books of the Commission and shall make an annual financial accounting and report in writing to the Members. Its books and records shall be available for examination by the Members at all reasonable times.
- **Section 9**. The Commission may delegate authority to its executive committee. Such delegation of authority shall be by motion of the Commission and may be conditioned in such a manner as the Commission may determine.
- **Section 10**. The Commission shall adopt By-Laws which may be amended from time to time.
- **Section 11**. The Commission shall be responsible for the PEG access channels and <u>local community media</u>, <u>including cable television programming within or for the geographic area of the Member cities of the Commission Should any Member withdraw from the Commission as of the date of any renewal of the Cable Television Franchise Ordinance, or in any year thereafter, the withdrawing Member shall assume all responsibility for PEG access cable television channels and programming within or for the geographic boundaries of the withdrawing municipality, as more specifically delineated in Article XI, Section 3, of this Agreement.</u>
- **Section 12**. The Commission may designate an entity or entities to perform any functions the Commission deems necessary relative to the Commission's responsibility for community programming. The Commission may provide funds, support services, and the use of equipment and property to the designated entity, provided that title to all equipment and property shall not pass to the designated entity without the prior approval of all directors.

#### IX. OFFICERS

- **Section 1**. The officers of the Commission shall consist of a chair, a vice-chair, and a secretary/treasurer. Officers of the Commission shall be elected annually for one-year terms. Officers shall be limited to two consecutive one-year terms in a given office.
- **Section 2**. A vacancy in the office of chair, vice-chair, or secretary/treasurer shall occur for any of the reasons for which a vacancy in the office of a director shall occur. Vacancies in these offices shall be filled by the Commission for the unexpired portion of the term.
  - **Section 3.** The three officers shall all be members of the executive committee.
- **Section 4**. The chair shall preside at all meetings of the Commission and the executive committee. The vice-chair shall act as chair in the absence of the chair.
- **Section 5**. The secretary/treasurer shall be responsible for keeping a record of all of the proceedings of the Commission and executive committee and shall be responsible for custody of all funds, for the keeping of all financial records of the Commission and for such other matters as shall be delegated by the Commission. The Commission may require that the secretary/treasurer post a fidelity bond or other insurance against loss of Commission funds in an amount approved by the Commission, at the expense of the Commission. Said fidelity bond or other insurance may cover all persons authorized to handle funds of the Commission.
- **Section 6**. The Commission may appoint such other officers as it deems necessary. All such officers shall be appointed from the membership of the Commission.

# X. FINANCIAL MATTERS

- **Section 1**. The fiscal year of the Commission shall be the calendar year.
- **Section 2**. Commission funds may be expended by the Commission in accordance with the procedures established by law for the expenditure of funds by Minnesota Statutory Cities. Orders, checks and drafts must be signed by any two of the officers. Other legal instruments shall be executed, with authority of the Commission, by the chair and secretary/treasurer. Contracts shall be let and purchases made in accordance with the procedures established by law for Minnesota Statutory Cities.
- **Section 3**. The financial contributions of the Members in support of the Commission shall be in direct proportion to the percent of annual franchise fee revenues of each Member to the total franchise fee revenues of the System for the prior year multiplied by the Commission's total annual assessment to the Members.
- **Section 4**. A proposed budget for the ensuing calendar year shall be formulated by the Commission and submitted to the Members on or before October 15. Final action adopting a budget for the ensuing calendar year shall be taken by the Commission on or before December 15 of each year.

**Section 5**. Any Member may inspect and copy the Commission books and records at any and all reasonable times. All books and records shall be kept in accordance with normal and accepted accounting procedures and principles used by Minnesota Statutory cities.

#### XI. DURATION

**Section 1**. The Commission shall continue for an indefinite term unless the number of Members shall become less than five. The Commission may also be terminated by mutual agreement of all of the Members at any time.

**Section 2**. In order to prevent obligation for its financial contribution to the Commission for the ensuing year, a Member shall withdraw from the Commission by filing a written notice with the Commission by July 1 of any year giving notice of withdrawal effective at the end of that calendar year; and membership shall continue until the effective date of the withdrawal. Prior to the effective date of withdrawal, a notice of withdrawal may be rescinded by October 15 by a Member. If a Member withdraws before dissolution of the Commission, the Member shall have no claim against the assets of the Commission. A Member withdrawing after October 15 shall be obligated to pay its entire contribution for the ensuing year as outlined in the budget of the Commission for the ensuing year.

**Section 3**. Should any Member withdraw from the Commission, the withdrawing member shall assume the responsibilities for PEG access cable television channels and programming within and for the geographic boundaries of the withdrawing municipality as described in Article VIII, section 11, herein.

**Section 4**. In the event of dissolution, the Commission shall determine the measures necessary to affect the dissolution and shall provide for the taking of such measures as promptly as circumstances permit, subject to the provisions of this Agreement. Upon dissolution of the Commission, all remaining assets of the Commission, after payment of obligations, shall be distributed among the then existing Members in proportion to the most recent Member-by-Member breakdown of the franchise fee as reported by the Grantee. The Commission shall continue to exist after dissolution for such period, no longer than six months, as is necessary to wind up its affairs but for no other purpose.

- Fees apply only for games and practices. Tournaments or special events/services are subject to additional fees.
- Field/Court/Rink use permits will be issued when payment and application are received.
- All short term rentals (1-5 times) entitle the customer to use of the field as is; anything additional will be the customer's responsibility (i.e. striping the field or providing bases.)
- Special request of services will be dealt with on a case by case basis and may include extra fees. All requests should be discussed with the Parks and Recreation Department at 651-792-7617.

#### E. FACILITY USE BY PUBLIC SERVICE ORGANIZATIONS

- 1. Public facilities are available for use on a reservation basis.
- 2. The following shall be allowed use of public facilities but set up/tear down fees apply:

    - Lauderdale and Falcon Heights Lions Club
    - Roseville Rotary Club
    - Party Precinct caucuses, legislated district conventions and county conventions under the requirements of MN State Statute 202A.192
    - AARP Tax Services
    - Hobby groups or clubs that meet the following criteria:
      - o Falcon Heights based (A minimum of 25% of on-going members or participants are Falcon Heights residents).
      - o Non-profit
      - o Open membership
      - o Founded on a hobby
      - Actively reaches out to include people of different ages, especially youth, to encourage intergenerational exchanges of information
      - Encourages a community service and/or benefit component
    - Falcon Heights neighborhood or community groups whose activities are open to all and for the sole purpose of developing, fostering and strengthening neighborhood and community well-being.
  - b. Any organization that meets the above guidelines yet uses a facility more than twice a year shall be charged \$100 per year.
  - c. The organization or group cannot be a private, business, political, or religious organization.
  - d. Any organization denied free use under this policy as defined in this section may appeal to the city council.

# J. SANITARY SEWER

The sanitary sewer fee for residential units is \$35.50 per quarter plus \$0.0232579 per cubic foot of water usage during the months of November – January. For apartment units, the rate will be \$35.50/unit/quarter plus \$0.0232579 per cubic foot of water used in November. For residential units, this will serve as the maximum fee for other quarters throughout the year, but the actual amount billed may be lower depending on water usage. For commercial units, the fee is \$0.0227572 per cubic foot of water usage during each month.

# K. STORM DRAINAGE

The fee for storm drainage is \$26.00 per quarter for residential units and \$240.08 per acre for commercial and apartment units.

#### L. HYDRANT WATER

The fee for hydrant water is 6% surcharge of the water bill.

#### M. RECYCLING

The recycling charge is \$10.50 per quarter for residential units.

# N. STREET LIGHTING

The street lighting fee is \$6.00 per quarter for residential units and \$0.02 per lineal foot frontage for commercial properties monthly.

# O. FEES FOR UNSPECIFIED REQUESTS

A private party or public institution (hereinafter applicant) making a request to the City for approval of a project or for public assistance must cover the City's consultants' costs associated with reviewing the request. Prior to having the request considered by the City, the applicant must deposit an escrow fee in an amount that is estimated to cover the City's consultants' costs as determined by the City Administrator. If the City's consultants' costs exceed the initial escrow deposited by the applicant, an additional escrow fee will be required to cover the additional costs. The City shall use the applicant's fees to cover the City's actual consultants' costs in reviewing the request regardless of the City's action on the applicant's request. If the applicant's escrow fees exceed the City's actual consultants' costs for reviewing the request, the remaining escrow fees shall be refunded to the applicant.

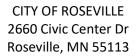

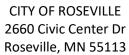

Description	It is the City's policy to assess a portion of street improvement costs. Per city assessment policy and state statute, the City holds public hearings to consider assessments for street improvement projects. This year's assessment proceeding is for the 2021 Pavement Management Project, which included improvements to the following streets:  • Tatum St, Larpenteur Ave to Roselawn Ave  • Lindig St, Larpenteur Ave to Maple Knoll Dr  • Saint Marys St, Larpenteur Ave to Maple Knoll Dr  • Saint Marys St, Larpenteur Ave to Hollywood Ct alley  • East Snelling Dr, Hoyt Ave to Hollywood Ct alley  • East Snelling Dr, Idaho Ave to dead end  • Asbury St, Crawford Ave to Roselawn Ave  • Arona St, Crawford Ave to Roselawn Ave  • Simpson St, Crawford Ave to Roselawn Ave  • Ruggles St, East Snelling Service Dr to Pascal St  • Pascal St, Larpenteur Ave to Roselawn Ave  • Crawford Ave, Simpson St to Pascal St  • Albert St, Larpenteur Ave to Garden Ave  The next step in the assessment process is consideration of a resolution declaring costs to be assessed and setting a hearing date for the assessments. It is recommended that the assessment hearing be held at the regularly scheduled council meeting on September 22, 2021.  The City follows the requirements of Chapter 429 of state statute for the assessment process. Once the assessment roll is adopted, the City allows for a 30-day pre-payment period. Following the pre-payment period, assessment rolls are certified to Ramsey County for collection. The City will have the rolls certified by mid-November in order to allow the County enough time to add the assessments in part or in full in October 2021 or have them added to their property taxes with an interest rate to be set by the City Council.

Families, Fields and Fair

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The first installment of the assessment would be due in Spring 2022.

## Budget Impact

Below is a Project Financing Summary detailing the projected actual project costs for this improvement. This project is being financed using the following funding sources:

- Assessments levied in accordance with the City's assessment policy.

# RESOLUTION ORDERING ASSESSMENT HEARING FOR 2021 PAVEMENT MANAGEMENT PROJECT

WHEREAS, on October 28, 2020, the City Council of the City of Falcon Heights held a public hearing for the purposes of accepting public comment on the proposed improvements associated with the 2021 PMP Project on the following streets and at the same meeting adopted Resolution Ordering the Improvement for the 2021 PMP Project;

WHEREAS, contracts have been let and the contract price for such improvement is \$991,874.40, and the expenses incurred or to be incurred in the making of such improvement amount to \$49,292.73 so that the total cost of the improvement will be \$1,090,459.85; and

WHEREAS, the City Administrator, with the assistance of the City Engineer, has calculated the proper amount to be specifically assessed for such improvement against every assessable lot, piece or parcel of land within the district affected, without regard to cash valuation, as provided by law, and has filed a copy of such proposed assessment in his office for public inspection; and

WHEREAS, the clerk has notified the council that such proposed assessment has been completed and filed in his/her office for public inspection,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Falcon Heights, Minnesota:

1. The portion of the cost of such improvements to be paid by the City is hereby declared to be \$599,379.29 and the portion of the cost to be assessed against benefited property owners is declared to be \$352,302.62

- 2. A hearing shall be held at 6:00 p.m. on the 22nd day of September, 2021 in the city hall located at 2077 Larpenteur Ave West to pass upon such proposed assessment. All persons owning property affected by such improvement will be given an opportunity to be heard with reference to such assessment.
- 3. The City Administrator is hereby directed to cause a notice of the hearing on the proposed assessment to be published once in the official newspaper at least two weeks prior to the hearing, and he shall state in the notice the total cost of the improvement. He shall also cause mailed notice to be given to the owner of each parcel described in the assessment roll not less than two weeks prior to the hearing.
- 4. The owner of any property so assessed may, at any time prior to certification of the assessment to the county auditor, pay the whole of the assessment on such property, with interest accrued to the date of payment, to the City Administrator, except that no interest shall be charged if the entire assessment is paid within 30 days from the adoption of the assessment. An owner may at any time thereafter, pay to the County Auditor the entire amount of the assessment remaining unpaid, with interest accrued to December 31 of the year in which such payment is made. Such payment must be made before November 15 or interest will be charged through December 31 of the succeeding year.
