**RESOLUTION NO. 2013-62**

**A RESOLUTION ORDERING PREPARATION OF A FEASIBILITY  
REPORT FOR THE INWOOD BOOSTER STATION AND  
TRUNK WATERMAIN IMPROVEMENTS**

**WHEREAS**, the 2014 water system capital improvement plan identifies a new water booster station together with the extension of trunk watermain along Inwood Avenue North, from 26<sup>th</sup> Street N. to the approximate site of Well No. 3, to provide municipal water service to the developing properties in the I94 corridor; and

**WHEREAS**, it is proposed to route this trunk watermain through the Parkview Estates neighborhood along Ivory Avenue N. and 15<sup>th</sup> Street N. in order to more cost effectively construct the water distribution system; and

**WHEREAS**, it is proposed to provide connection service stubs to properties located adjacent to the trunk watermain improvements; and

**WHEREAS**, it is proposed to assess a portion of the cost of the improvements pursuant to the City's Special Assessment Policy and Minnesota Statutes, Chapter 429.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED,**

1. FOCUS Engineering is instructed to complete a feasibility report in accordance with Minnesota Statutes, Chapter 429 for the proposed improvements, and to report to the council with all convenient speed advising the council in a preliminary way as to whether the proposed improvement is necessary, cost-effective, and feasible; whether it should best be made as proposed or in connection with some other improvement; the estimated cost of the improvement as recommended; and a description of the methodology used to calculate individual assessments for affected parcels and to not exceed a cost of \$6,700 unless approved by the City Administrator.
