Area Event Timeline

1819 - Fort Snelling established

1820's - Trail established between Stillwater and St. Paul

1846 - Road between Stillwater and St. Paul opened.

1847 –Oakdale Township surveyed and platted by Isaac Higby.

1848 – Stillwater public meeting to convene territorial convention.

1848 – Territorial Convention in Stillwater. Will become known as the "Birthplace of Minnesota".

1848 – Washington County established as one of nine original counties.

1849 – Minnesota Territory Created

1849 - Stillwater is surveyed and platted by Harvey Wilson.

1852 – Stillwater and St. Paul incorporated as cities in Minnesota Territory.

1858 – Minnesota granted statehood

1858 – Oakdale Township organized at Lake House Hotel near Sunfish Lake.

1860 - Barn built

1862 – Dakota War / Sioux Uprising

1872 - Railroad reaches Minnesota from Chicago

1876 - First Stillwater Bridge spans the St. Croix River at Stillwater opens.

1926 - Lake Elmo separates from Oakdale
