RESOLUTION NO. 2019-051

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING PUBLICATION OF ORDINANCE 08-225

WHEREAS, the Lake Elmo City Council has adopted Ordinance No. 08-225, an ordinance amending Chapter 53 Storm Water Management Utility to establish stormwater area districts

WHEREAS, the ordinance is lengthy; and

WHEREAS, Minnesota Statutes, section 412.191, subd. 4, allows publication by title and summary in the case of lengthy ordinances or those containing charts or maps; and

WHEREAS, the City Council believes that the following summary would clearly inform the public of the intent and effect of the ordinance.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Lake Elmo, that the City Clerk shall cause the following summary of Ordinance No. 08-225 to be published in the official newspaper in lieu of the entire ordinance:

Public Notice

The City Council of the City of Lake Elmo has adopted Ordinance No. 08-225 that establishes a Downtown Regional Storm Water District and connection charge, and a Regional Infiltration Basin Storm Water District and volume control use charge. The Downtown Storm Water District establishment will enable properties to utilize the existing City infrastructure that currently has excess capacity available to meet City and watershed permitting requirements instead of constructing new infrastructure for their projects.

The following is a summary of the adopted ordinance language:

SECTION 1. The City Council of the City of Lake Elmo hereby amends Title V, Chapter 53, Storm Water Management Utility, by adding a new Section 53.10 as follows:

§ 53.10 STORMWATER AREA DISTRICTS.

Establishes a Downtown Regional Storm Water District and connection charge, and a Regional Infiltration Basin Storm Water District and volume control use charge.

The full text of Ordinance No. 08-225 is available for inspection at Lake Elmo City Offices during regular business hours.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Lake Elmo that the City Administrator keep a copy of the ordinance at City Hall for public inspection and that a full copy of the ordinance be placed in a public location within the City.
