ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

Minnesota Rules Chapter 169.14 subd. 2. (7) allows a city to adopt a 25 mph speed limit for residential roadways.

In March, 2005, the city adopted a policy for establishing 25 mph speed limits within specific neighborhood areas (Resolution No. 2003-015).

In accordance with city policy, it is recommended that the recently constructed developments be posted at 25 mph speed limits.
