ISSUE BEFORE COUNCIL: Should the City Council approve a security reduction for Southwind at Lake Elmo?

PROPOSAL DETAILS/ANALYSIS: Staff has received and processed requests to reduce the development security for Southwind at Lake Elmo. This request has been reviewed and the following reduction is being recommended:

Current Security Amount \$793,403

Proposed Security Amount \$581.018

1. Southwind at Lake Elmo

The Southwind at Lake Elmo 2-year warranty period for the watermain and sanitary sewer has ended and all warranty corrections have been completed by the developer. The twenty-five percent (25%) warranty security is therefore recommended for release. In addition, a landscaping improvement inspection was completed and partial reduction in landscape security is recommended in accordance with the inspection findings.

<u>FISCAL IMPACT</u>: It is the City's goal to retain at all times during the subdivision improvements a security amount that is adequate to ensure completion of all elements of the improvements as protection to the City tax payers against the potential of developer default.

RECOMMENDATION: Staff is recommending that the City Council, as part of the Consent Agenda, approve the security reduction for Southwind at Lake Elmo as detailed in the attached worksheet. If removed from the consent agenda, the recommended motion for the action is as follows:

"Move to approve the security reduction for Southwind at Lake Elmo as detailed in the attached Security Reduction Worksheet".
