**AGENDA ITEM:** Sale of Excess and Retired Equipment

**<u>BACKGROUND:</u>** With the acquisition of new equipment, excess equipment, other equipment that has reached the end of its useful life and contracting out city mowing services, Public Works has a surplus of equipment that is no longer operational or needed to conduct city services.

**ISSUE BEFORE COUNCIL:** Should the City Council authorize staff to publicly advertise and sell excess and retired city equipment consistent with the City's Purchasing Policy?

**<u>FISCAL IMPACT:</u>** Revenue generated by the sale of this equipment will be added to the Equipment Replacement Fund. Below is a list of surplus equipment and the anticipated sale price.
