INTOXICATING LIQUOR LICENSES. The Lake Elmo City Council hereby ordains that Section 1201.030C and Section that Section 1201.030C and Section 1202.020D of the Lake Elmo Code are hereby amended to read as follows:

1201.030C. Temporary On-Sale Licenses. Temporary on-sale licenses shall be issued only to clubs or charitable, religious, or other non-profit organizations in existence for at least three years and shall authorize the on sale of intoxicating liquor in connection with a sale of intexteating inquor in connection with a social event sponsored by the licensee and subject to the restrictions imposed by M.S. Chapter 340A. No more than three temporary on-sale licenses may be issued to any one organization or for anyone location, within a twelve-month period.

1202.020D. Temporary License. A club or charitable, religious or non-profit organization may be issued a temporary "on-sale" license for the sale of non-intoxicating malt liquor on or off school grounds, in and out of school houses, and school buildings, and in or outside of public parks. No more than three temporary on-sale licenses may be issued to any one organization or for one location, within a
