AGENDA ITEM: 38th-39th St MPCA Grant Amendment **SUBMITTED BY**: Kristina Handt, City Administrator

BACKGROUND:

On October 20, 2020, the city council approved a grant agreement with the MPCA for water main extension to 38-39th St loop off of Ideal Ave. At the time, the project included approximately \$200,000 to replace the existing 6-inch Pressure Reducing Valve and 6-inch watermain north of Lake Jane Trail to the Oakdale Interconnect, and approximately \$84,000 in watermain oversize costs to install a portion of the watermain extension through the neighborhood with 12-inch trunk watermain in lieu of the city standard 8-inch watermain. Staff had requested these additional costs to be considered grant eligible but did not want to hold up the project planning waiting for an answer. Staff argued the costs should be included because, if not for PFAS in the area, none of the neighborhoods outside of the MUSA would have been required to be on city water. At the end of January we were notified our grant agreement was amended to include these costs.

ISSUE BEFORE COUNCIL:

Who should the Council approve the 38th-39th St Grant Agreement Amendment with MPCA?

PROPOSAL:

Included in your packet is a copy of the grant agreement amendment that would increase the total funding available to \$3,984,000, an increase of \$284,000 from the original grant.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Covers all water related costs associated with the project now.

This amendment is by and between the State of Minnesota, acting through its Commissioner of the **Minnesota Pollution Control Agency**, 520 Lafayette Road North, St. Paul, MN 55155-4194 ("MPCA" or "State") and **City of Lake Elmo**, 3800 Laverne Avenue North, Lake Elmo, MN 55042 ("Grantee" or "Contractor").

Recitals

- The State has a grant contract with the Grantee identified as SWIFT Contract Number 184198 ("Original Grant Agreement") to provide the 38th Street and 39th Street Extension of Municipal Water Supply Project.
- 2. The Original Agreement is being amended to increase the overall grant amount to accommodate for oversize piping needed to service per- and polyfluoroalkyl substances impacted houses.
- 3. The State and the Grantee are willing to amend the Original Grant Agreement as stated below.

Grant Agreement Amendment

In this Amendment, changes to pre-existing Agreement language will use strike through for deletions and underlining for insertions.

REVISION 1. Clause 2. "Grantee's Duties and Well Sealing" is amended as follows:

- 2. Grantee's Duties and Well Sealing
 - **2.1 Grantee's duties.** The Grantee, who is not a state employee, will perform the duties specified in **Revised Attachment A**, which is attached and incorporated into this grant agreement.
 - **2.2 Well Sealing.** All associated wells are required to be properly sealed and abandoned as part of the project within the timeframe of the grant agreement. All well sealing will follow

Minnesota Department of Health (MDH) regulations and will only be done by licensed well contractors.

Reimbursement for individual/residential water service connections and well sealing will not occur until proof of well sealing has been provided to MPCA.

MPCA may identify certain wells as potential monitoring wells. If agreed upon by MPCA, the City and the well owner, MPCA will assume responsibility of converting those wells to monitoring wells. In these instances, proof of well sealing is not required for reimbursement of individual/residential water service connection costs.

REVISION 2. Clause 4.1 "Consideration" is amended as follows:

- **4.1 Consideration**. The State will pay for all services performed by the Grantee under this grant agreement as follows:
 - (a) Compensation. The MPCA will reimburse the Grantee according to approved invoices relating to the 38th Street and 39th Street Avenue Extension of Municipal Water Supply Project. The MPCA will review the expense documentation submitted by the Grantee for the costs and will reimburse the Grantee for reasonable and necessary expenditures, as determined by the MPCA.
 - (b) Travel expenses. Reimbursement for travel and subsistence expenses actually and necessarily incurred by the Grantee as a result of this grant agreement will not exceed \$0.00; provided that the Grantee will be reimbursed for travel and subsistence expenses in the same manner and in no greater amount than provided in the current "Commissioner's Plan" promulgated by the Commissioner of Minnesota Management and Budget (MMB). The Grantee will not be reimbursed for travel and subsistence expenses incurred outside Minnesota unless it has received the State's prior written approval for out of state travel. Minnesota will be considered the home state for determining whether travel is out of state.
 - (c) Total obligation. The total obligation of the State for all compensation and reimbursements to the Grantee under this grant agreement will not exceed \$3,700,000.00 (Three Million Seven Hundred Thousand Dollars and Zero Cents) \$3,984,000.00 (Three Million Nine Hundred Eighty-four Thousand Dollars and Zero Cents).

Except as amended herein, the terms and conditions of the Original Grant Agreement and all previous amendments and change orders remain in full force and effect. The Original Grant Agreement and any previous amendments and change orders are incorporated into this amendment by reference.

2. Statement of Problems, Opportunities, and Existing Conditions

This project will extend clean drinking water to 49 homes located in the Bordners Garner Farmettes subdivision, in the general area bounded by 38th street, 39th street and Innsdale Avenue in the City of Lake Elmo by extending the municipal water system to serve each property. The project extends a 12-inch watermain from the adjacent Wildflower Shores subdivision. Approximately 7,200 feet of watermain will be extended to enable water service lines be installed to each home. Grant funds will also be used for sealing of private wells currently used by each residence. The properties reside in an area where per- and polyfluoroalkyl substances (PFAS) contamination exceeds Health Based Values (HBVs) and well advisories have been issued. The project is consistent with the long-term drinking water supply plan to address PFAS contamination to drinking water supplies in the East Metro area.

Individual water services will be stubbed from the main line for each of the 49 residential properties. The project will include grant funding and administrative processes for ensuring each property completes the private service connection from the service stub to each home, including water meter installation, sealing of the private well, removal of any existing granular activated carbon (GAC) filters, and all permitting and connection fees. The City intends to directly implement the public improvement portion of the project for the water main components that will remain owned and operated by the City and will require property owners to contract directly for the work to be completed on their individual properties. The private property work will be funded on a reimbursement basis. The City will distribute materials, provided by the MPCA, regarding individual/residential water service connections and well sealing to all residents impacted by this project.

In accordance with the City's standard Capital Improvement Program process a feasibility study and project design will be completed to ready the project for 2021 construction. Bids will be received in early 2021 with construction to commence in May 2021. The water main will be tested, operational and ready for connection to the individual properties in late 2021.

No environmental review is required to implement this project. The project will require the following permits:

- · Minnesota Department of Health Watermain Extension Permit
- Washington County Right-of-Way Permit
- Valley Branch Watershed District Permit
- MPCA National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System Construction Permit

3. Measurable Outcomes

The City will report at least quarterly to the MPCA regarding progress of the project. The City will also report to the MPCA as part of the quarterly report the itemized costs incurred for that quarter for reimbursement by the MPCA. Monthly reimbursement requests can be provided as determined by the City.
