## **RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING PUBLICATION OF ORDINANCE 08-247**

## **Public Notice**

The City Council of the City of Lake Elmo has adopted Ordinance No. 08-247, which amends the language and standards for Tree Preservation within Section 154.257 of the City's Zoning Code. The following is a summary of the adopted ordinance language:

The proposed changes to the Lake Elmo Tree Preservation Ordinance include adding definitions and adding language that clarifies when the city will require a tree preservation plan and when the city will not require a tree preservation plan. The City is <u>not</u> proposing any changes to the type or size of trees that are used for determining the amount of tree replacement or those a developer may remove or the amount of allowable tree removal on a new development or redevelopment site.

The full text of Ordinance No. 08-247 is available for inspection at Lake Elmo City Offices during regular business hours.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the City Council of the City of Lake Elmo that the City Administrator keep a copy of the ordinance at City Hall for public inspection and that a full copy of the ordinance be placed in a public location within the City.
