PROPOSED DEFINITION CHANGES:

Impervious surface means any structure or surface which interferes to any degree with the direct absorption of water into the ground, including, but not limited to, building footprints, sidewalks, paved or gravel driveways and parking

areas, patios, sport courts, or any other similar surface. Decks, pervious landscaping fabric, the surface water of pools and retaining walls shall not be included as impervious surface.

M/S/P: Vrieze / Steil made a motion to recommend adoption of the proposed text amendment, amending the impervious surface definition in Section 1.08.010 Definitions as presented **Vote: 3-0, motion carried unanimously.** (Mueller, Rehkamp absent) no discussion.
