BACKGROUND:

Since the planning department will be without staff for a period of time while we search for new hires, I reached out to a couple of firms to provide planning services in the interim. The planning director position has been posted and closes August 4th. We hope to have someone on board by late September/early October and then begin the recruitment process for a planner. That position would be expected to be filled in November/December. In the meantime, the city will be required to process numerous land use applications and needs to update the Village AUAR by December (5 year deadline) to keep it current. With a small staff in other departments there is nowhere to pull from to meet all of these demands. We have been training our GIS intern on some planning activities but her time will be mostly for review of building applications, fence permits, encroachment agreements and other minor items.

ISSUE BEFORE COUNCIL:

Who should the Council select to provide interim planning services?

PROPOSAL:

I reached out to Bolton and Menk and Swanson Haskamp Consulting (SHC) for interim planning services starting mid-August through the end of the year likely in some capacity. Copies of both of their proposals are included in your packet.

Bolton and Menk:

Bolton and Menk will provide three planning staff to provide planning services. Their rates are listed below. They will be able to provide 3 office days a week, attend Planning Commission and Council meetings and process applications. So there is consistency they will provide a second person at the Planning Commission meetings, at no cost, who will attend the Council meeting.

Examples of these projects include environmental reviews, master plans, small area studies, complete zoning ordinance rewrites or other special planning studies. We will work with the city to define a scope of services and budget, as they come up.

Dear Ms. Handt, Mayor and Members of the Council,

Thank you for reaching out to us and requesting this proposal for Interim Planning Services. Our firm has enjoyed working with the City of Lake Elmo over the past several years, and we are confident that we can effectively assist the City during this time of transition. Over the past four years SHC has worked collaboratively with the City Council, Planning Commission and Staff on the successful completion of the 2040 Comprehensive Plan ("2040 Plan") and we also provided Interim Planning Services during the last staff transition in 2018. Having prepared your 2040 Plan we are intimately familiar with your development and redevelopment objectives, the current market demand and pressures from the development community, and the importance of processing land use applications accurately and timely.

We believe that SHC's ongoing relationship with Lake Elmo offers the following efficiencies:

- We will staff the Interim Services with the same staff that worked on the 2040 Plan. This will lead to a more seamless transition, and will allow us to step in immediately with minimal required catch-up.
- SHC understands the City's vision, goals and strategies and Future Land Use Plan as adopted within your 2040 Plan. We have all mapping/GIS for the City from the 2040 Plan process as well as the technical analysis and data to evaluate proposed development for consistency with required density ranges, household units and sewer/water flows.
- Over the past decade SHC has provided planning services for multiple municipalities in Washington County, and we continue to serve the cities of Grant, Lakeland and Lakeland Shores with on-going daily services. We have relationships with Washington County, the watershed districts and DNR which will help facilitate a smooth land use application review processes.
- SHC has positive working relationships with City Staff and your professional service staff. We worked closely with your engineering consultants during the 2040 Plan, and understand the importance of strong staff communication and coordination during this time of transition.

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LETTER, APPROACH & OBJECTIVES

After a brief discussion with Ms. Handt, we understand that the City's Planning Department is in full transition with the eventual departure of both the Planning Director and City Planner in August 2021. Given the staff departure we understand the following needs and objectives regarding this Interim Services contract:

- From mid-August to early October the City will require the most assistance since no planning department staff will be available. During this period SHC will step in and perform as your interim staff attending meetings, processing land use applications and answering resident/staff/business/developer inquiries.
- The City's objective is to have a new Planning Director in place by the end of September or early October. Once a new Planning Director is on board, SHC will assist with the transition and provide additional support as necessary and requested.
- From October through December 2021 SHC will support the City's new Planning Director as requested. We understand that the timing of our services and level of support will be dependent on when a new City Planner is hired to support the Planning Director.

In addition to the daily planning services, we understand that there are some known planning activities and projects that may require additional support and our team is prepared and equipped to assist with those efforts. For example the north point development project may require an AUAR and the Village AUAR needs to be updated by the end of 2021. SHC has extensive experience working with developers and cities on the environmental review process including the preparation of EAW, EIS and AUARs. We understand that some of these projects may extend beyond the terms of the interim services performed between August and December, and we are prepared as needed to assist the City with the completion of any active projects.

Based on our understanding of the City's needs and expectations, we propose the following staff to perform on this contract:

- Jennifer Haskamp, AICP will be the point of contact, Principal Planner and Project Manager. Jennifer will attend the design review staff meetings, City Council and Planning Commission meetings. She will prepare and perform analysis of land use applications and will coordinate with City Staff throughout the development review process.
- Ellison Yahner, AICP will provide support and assistance throughout the contract. She will provide office hours as coordinated with Ms. Handt, and she will be available via email or phone to answer developer/resident/business owner inquiries. Ellison worked with the City on the 2040 Plan and is intimately familiar with the community. She will attend meetings as needed throughout this contract.
