BACKGROUND:

On February 4, 2020, the city council approved a grant agreement with the MPCA for water main extension to the Hamlet on Sunfish Lake neighborhood. On April 6, 2021, the first amendment was approved in order to increase the cost after receiving bids. Staff recently sought a second amendment to increase costs again and extend the timeline to be able to cover the warranty period.

ISSUE BEFORE COUNCIL:

Who should the Council approve the Hamlet on Sunfish Lake Grant Agreement Amendment 2 with MPCA?

PROPOSAL:

Included in your packet is a copy of the grant agreement amendment that would increase the total funding available to \$3,398,200, an increase of \$200,000. The deadline would be extended two months from October 31, 2023 to December 31, 2023.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Covers all water related costs associated with the project now.

This amendment is by and between the State of Minnesota, acting through its Commissioner of the **Minnesota Pollution Control Agency**, 520 Lafayette Road North, St. Paul, MN 55155-4194 ("MPCA" or "State") and **City of Lake Elmo**, 3800 Laverne Avenue North, Lake Elmo, MN 55042 ("Grantee" or "Contractor").

Recitals

1. The State has a grant contract with the Grantee identified as SWIFT Contract Number 165904 ("Original Grant Agreement") to provide the **Hamlet on Sunfish Lake Extension of Municipal Water Supply Project**.
2. The Original Agreement is being amended to increase the overall grant amount and extend the expiration date.
3. The State and the Grantee are willing to amend the Original Grant Agreement as stated below.

Grant Agreement Amendment

In this Amendment, changes to pre-existing Agreement language will use ~~strike through~~ for deletions and underlining for insertions.

REVISION 1. Clause 1. "**Term of Grant Agreement**" is amended as follows:

1. Term of Grant Agreement

- 1.1 **Effective date:** March 2, 2020, or the date the State obtains all required signatures under [Minn. Stat. § 16B.98](#), subd. 5, whichever is later. Per Minn.Stat. §16B.98 Subd. 7, no payments will be made to the Grantee until this grant contract is fully executed.
- 1.2 **Expiration date:** ~~October 31, 2023~~ December 31, 2023, or until all obligations have been satisfactorily fulfilled, whichever occurs first.

- 1.3 Survival of terms.** The following clauses survive the expiration or cancellation of this grant agreement: Indemnification; State Audits; Government Data Practices and Intellectual Property; Publicity and Endorsement; Governing Law, Jurisdiction, and Venue; and Data Disclosure.

REVISION 2. Clause 2. "Grantee's Duties and Well Sealing" is amended as follows:

2. Grantee's Duties and Well Sealing

- 2.1 Grantee's duties.** The Grantee, who is not a state employee, will perform the duties specified in **Revised Attachment A Amendment 2**, which is attached and incorporated into this grant agreement.

- 2.2 Well Sealing.** All associated wells are required to be properly sealed and abandoned as part of the project within the timeframe of the grant agreement. All well sealing will follow Minnesota Department of Health (MDH) regulations and will only be done by licensed well contractors.

Reimbursement for individual/residential water service connections and well sealing will not occur until proof of well sealing has been provided to MPCA.

MPCA may identify certain wells as potential monitoring wells. If agreed upon by MPCA, the City and the well owner, MPCA will assume responsibility of converting those wells to monitoring wells. In these instances, proof of well sealing is not required for reimbursement of individual/residential water service connection costs.

REVISION 3. Clause 4.1 "Consideration" is amended as follows:

- 4.1 Consideration.** The State will pay for all services performed by the Grantee under this grant agreement as follows:

(a) Compensation. The MPCA will reimburse the Grantee according to approved invoices relating to the Hamlet on Sunfish Lake Extension of Municipal Water Supply Project. The MPCA will review the expense documentation submitted by the Grantee for the costs and will reimburse the Grantee for reasonable and necessary expenditures, as determined by the MPCA.


(b) Travel expenses. Reimbursement for travel and subsistence expenses actually and necessarily incurred by the Grantee as a result of this grant agreement will not exceed \$0.00; provided that the Grantee will be reimbursed for travel and subsistence expenses in the same manner and in no greater amount than provided in the current "Commissioner's Plan" promulgated by the Commissioner of Minnesota Management and Budget (MMB). The Grantee will not be reimbursed for travel and subsistence expenses incurred outside Minnesota unless it has received the State's prior written approval for out of state travel. Minnesota will be considered the home state for determining whether travel is out of state.

(c) Total obligation. The total obligation of the State for all compensation and reimbursements to the Grantee under this grant agreement will not exceed ~~\$3,198,200.00 (Three Million One Hundred Ninety-eight Thousand Two Hundred Dollars and Zero Cents)~~ **\$3,398,200.00 (Three Million Three Hundred Ninety-eight Thousand Two Hundred Dollars and Zero Cents).**

Except as amended herein, the terms and conditions of the Original Grant Agreement and all previous

amendments and change orders remain in full force and effect. The Original Grant Agreement and any previous amendments and change orders are incorporated into this amendment by reference.

2. Statement of Problems, Opportunities, and Existing Conditions

The Hamlet on Sunfish Lake neighborhood is located at the intersection of Kindred Way North and 43rd Street North. This project will extend clean drinking water to 41 homes located in the Hamlet on Sunfish Lake neighborhood in the City of Lake Elmo by extending the municipal water system into the neighborhood prior to reconstructing the neighborhood streets as scheduled for improvement in 2021 in the City's street capital improvement plan. The project extends the public watermain into the neighborhood from the intersection of Kindred Way North and 43rd Street North, then along the public streets to the south end of the neighborhood at Kindred Court, then east to make a looped watermain connection to the adjacent Legacy at North Star development. The southern loop properties reside in an area where PFAS contamination exceeds HBV and well advisories have been issued and all properties, including the northern loop, reside within the Special Well Construction Area designated by the Minnesota Department of Health in March, 2007 due to the proximity of PFAS in the groundwater. Individual water service stubs will be installed to the edge of right-of-way at each of the 41 residential properties. The project will include restoration following the watermain installation and this will include a street reclamation for the public streets along with boulevard sodding to restore all disturbed areas. Sanitary sewer utility repairs/replacement may be incorporated as part of the project, but these costs will be 100% assessed to the benefitting properties.

The project will include grant funding and administrative processes for ensuring each property completes the private service connection from the right-of-way to each home, including water meter installation, sealing of the private well, and all permitting and connection fees. The City intends to implement the public improvement portion of the project that remains within the public right-of-way and will require property owners to contract directly for the work to be completed on individual properties. The private property work will be funded on a reimbursement basis.

In accordance with the City's standard CIP process a feasibility study and project design will be completed in 2020 to ready the project for 2021 construction. Bids will be received in early 2021 with construction to commence in May 2021. The watermain will be tested, operational and ready for connection to the individual properties in late 2021.

No environmental review is required to implement this project. The project will require the following permits:

- Minnesota Department of Health (MDH) Watermain Extension Permit.
- Met Council/MPCA Sanitary Sewer Permit (if sewer repairs are needed).
- Valley Branch Watershed District Permit.
- MPCA NPDES Construction Permit.

3. Measurable Outcomes

The City will report at least quarterly to the MPCA regarding progress of the project. The City will also report to the MPCA as part of the quarterly report the itemized costs incurred for that quarter for reimbursement by the MPCA. Monthly reimbursement requests can be provided as determined by the City.
