BACKGROUND:

The 2023 budget provided for a planning intern. While we had expected to wait until we got into the new facility before bringing on this position, given the challenges in filling other positions in the community development department and the fact that we are only a couple months away from moving into the new city center, staff is proposing we advertise for a planning intern now.
