ISSUE BEFORE COUNCIL: Should the City Council approve release of warranty security for public sanitary sewer and watermain improvements for the Union Park 1st Addition?

PROPOSAL DETAILS/ANALYSIS: Staff has received and processed a request to release development security for the Union Park 1st Addition. The 2-year warranty period for public sanitary sewer and watermain in Union Park 1st Addition expired on April 20, 2023. A warranty walk-through has been completed by city staff and all warranty punch list items have since been addressed by the developer.

1. Union Park 1st Addition

The remaining proposed security would remain in place for the public street improvement and landscaping.

FISCAL IMPACT: Release of the warranty security closes out the public sanitary sewer and watermain improvements portion of the development. The operation and maintenance of these facilities becomes the responsibility of the city going forward.

RECOMMENDATION: Staff is recommending that the City Council, *as part of the Consent Agenda*, approve the release of warranty security for public sanitary sewer and watermain improvements in Union Park 1st Addition, all contingent on the developer being current with all other payments and obligations in accordance with the Development Agreement, including a positive escrow balance as required by the City. If removed from the consent agenda, the recommended motion for the action is as follows:

"Move to approve the security release for the Union Park 1st Addition as detailed in the respective Security Reduction Worksheet, contingent on the developer being current with all other payments and obligations in accordance with the Development Agreement, including a positive escrow balance as required by the City."
