**WHEREAS**, the ordinance is lengthy; and


**WHEREAS**, Minnesota Statutes, section 412.191, subd. 4, allows publication by title and

published in the official newspaper in lieu of the entire ordinance:


**Public Notice**

The City Council of the city of Lake Elmo has adopted Ordinance No. 08-008. The ordinance amends certain sign definitions to provide needed clarity, updates the sign purpose section to clarify what the sign ordinance is proposed to achieve, amends regulations on temporary signs, allows for off-premises advertising of agricultural sales businesses, and amends regulations governing on-premises signs for agricultural sales businesses and real estate developments. The full text of Ordinance No. 08-008 is available for inspection at Lake Elmo city hall during regular business hours.


