**WHEREAS**, the ordinance is lengthy; and


**WHEREAS**, Minnesota Statutes, section 412.191, subd. 4, allows publication by title and

published in the official newspaper in lieu of the entire ordinance:


**Public Notice**

The City Council of the city of Lake Elmo has adopted Ordinance No. 08-006. The ordinance  
makes changes to the application process for permanent and temporary signs, spells out the specific  
ways in which the city will calculate sign height and sign area, and adds legal language to protect  
the ordinance against lawsuits and to allow noncommercial speech in lieu of permitted commercial  
signage if desired. The full text of Ordinance No. 08-006 is available for inspection at Lake Elmo  
city hall during regular business hours.
