

A RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF HF 3997 AND SF 3703 CONCERNING SOLID WASTE  
LANDFILL BEING SITED IN HIGH RISK AREAS

- WHEREAS,** the City of Lake Elmo that is charged with protecting the public health and safety of its citizens; and
- WHEREAS,** the City of Lake Elmo is required to protect the quality of the groundwater for drinking and other purposes; and
- WHEREAS,** the City of Lake Elmo has concerns about the threat to public health and safety from siting landfills in areas that are high risk to groundwater contamination; and
- WHEREAS,** the City of Lake Elmo has concerns regarding the proposed landfill that has been proposed in West Lakeland Township of Washington County; and
- WHEREAS,** Representative Bunn has authored a bill in the House (HF 3997) and Senator Saltzman has authored a bill in the senate (SF 3703) that would prevent future solid waste landfills from being sited where geologic conditions are such that there is a high risk of ground water contamination; and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the City Council of the City of Lake Elmo, expresses its support for the proposed legislation HF 3997 and SF 3707.
