RESOLUTION NO. 2016-24

**A RESOLUTION RECEIVING A FEASIBILITY REPORT AND
ADOPTING PROJECT ASSESSMENT POLICY FOR THE
OLD VILLAGE PHASE 2 STREET, DRAINAGE AND UTILITY
IMPROVEMENTS AND CALLING HEARING ON IMPROVEMENT**

WHEREAS, pursuant to city council authorization, adopted on February 2, 2016, a feasibility report has been prepared by FOCUS Engineering, Inc. for the Old Village Phase 2 Street, Drainage and Utility Improvements; and

WHEREAS, the feasibility report recommends that benefitting properties be assessed all or a portion of the cost of the improvements pursuant to the city's Special Assessment Policy and Minnesota Statutes, Chapter 429; and

WHEREAS, the feasibility report provides information regarding whether the proposed improvement is necessary, cost-effective, and feasible; whether it should best be made as proposed or in connection with some other improvement; the estimated cost of the improvements as recommended; and a description of the methodology used to calculate individual assessments for affected parcels.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED,

1. That the City Council will consider the improvements in accordance with the report and the assessments of the abutting properties for all or a portion of the cost of the improvements pursuant to Minnesota Statutes, Chapter 429 at an estimated total project cost of \$9,312,677; consisting of the street and landscape improvements at \$5,810,611, sanitary sewer improvements at \$1,436,740, streetscape improvements at \$81,000, regional drainage improvements at \$254,016, and water system improvements of \$1,730,310.
2. A public hearing shall be held on such proposed improvements on the 3rd day of May, 2016, in the council chambers of the City Hall at or approximately after 7:00 P.M. and the clerk shall give mailed and published notice of such hearing and improvement as required by law.


