Chairman Kohn opened meeting and introduced Mr. Collopy. Discussion at this meeting would concern method of plat development. Mr. Collopy's proposal on plat would be pertinent to commission's agenda. Suggested proposal for plat development, after much discussion, was as follows:

First lot by developer will require no approval by Planning Commission; however, before building permit is issued, it must have building inspectors approval. Before developer can sell second lot he must present a plan for the general area that is proposed for future development.

as stated in Par 2, #15 of Ord. #16

Road (standard, basic requirements) must then be completed to extreme boundary of the next lot sold. Escrow for black-top must then be deposited with the sale of each lot.

After five building permits have been issued within a one year period, developer must plat complete area and comply with sub-division ordinance.
