### MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF NOVEMBER 9, 1976

Meeting called to order by Chairman Grace at 8 pm.

Roll Call: Dreher, Johnson, Grace, Crombie, Lundquist, Novak (8:10), Armstrong (8:15), Tom Loucks, Midwest Planning

Don Raleigh: Minor Subdivision - Variance Request Chairman Grace set the Hearing for November 22, 1976 at 7:40 pm for the variance request of Mr. Raleigh.

Ron Weber: Subdivision of 7.5 acres in Lot D. Registered Land Survey #54, Section 11.

Mr. Weber would like to divide the above described parcel into two lots, the front lot being 4.1 acres and the back lot 3.27 acres. Presently, access to the rear of the property is by a 66 ft easement.

In order to provide adequate road frontage to the rear lot the easement should be brought up to improved street standards, according to our present ordinance. It was suggested Mr. Weber talk to the owner of the easement, and inquire if he would dedicate the easement to the City. Also, it was suggested that the matter be refered to Don Raleigh for research.

Dr. McCollar: Vacation of property in Lanes DeMontreville Country Club, lying between boundary of Lots 675-676 and 680-681 and Lake DeMontreville.

The Commission recommended Dr. McCollar make a formal application for vacation of the described property. A Public Hearing will then be set by the Council to vacate the property.

Midwest Planning: Tom Loucks reviewed the Subdivision Regulations.

Since the text is quite lengthy it was recommended that the Commission review the remainder of the document and have comments and questions ready for the next meeting.

Minutes: Correction to the Minutes of October 25, 1976 relate to the vote on the Minor Subdivision - Variance Request of Don Raleigh. The vote should have read, Motion carried 6-0 with labstention, Armstrong.

Motion by Armstrong to approve the minutes as corrected. Seconded by Dreher. Motion carried 7-0
