## INFORMATION MEMO

RE: October 10, 1983 Planning Commission Meeting

The Planning Commission's agenda for October 10, 1983 is very light. As you can see, three sets of minutes should be approved. The 9-26-83 and corrected 9-12-83 minutes are enclosed. The corrected 9-26-83 minutes will be sent out to you tomorrow as the City should be receiving these minutes from Ilene Johnson on Friday.

I will not be attending this meeting as I will be out of town on business but some of the Planning Commission members that were present at the Joint Planning Commission meeting with the City of Oakdale should discuss what took place at this joint meeting.

Basically, the two cities determined that:

- 1. The possible placement of the horse racing track in Woodbury is an important issue to all surrounding cities. Note that in November, the City of Woodbury will be inviting surrounding governmental officials to an informational meeting relative to the horse racing track.
- These joint meetings are good informational workshops for both communities and that at minimum, these joint meetings should be held bi-annually.
- 3. Issues of common concern, such as development near our common boundaries, sewer extension for Lake Elmo Section 32 North into Oakdale or street development becomes closer to reality, that these joint meetings should be held more often for these concerns.
- 4. Those cities recognize a water supply problem around the contaminated landfill in Lake Elmo and that we are not opposed to the County considering (along with all the other options) our Lake Elmo residents receiving water from Oakdale supply system.

Enclosed is a sample resolution for your consideration relative to paragraph #4 above, and if you find this resolution acceptable, it would then be presented to the City Council with your recommen-
