**RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE RAMSEY COUNTY DISTRICT COURT
RETAIN THE CURRENT SCHEDULING SYSTEM FOR
SUBURBAN CRIMINAL CASES**

WHEREAS, the City of Falcon Heights has its gross misdemeanor and misdemeanor cases heard in Ramsey County District Court; and

WHEREAS, the Ramsey County District Court has under consideration the adoption of a new criminal court assignment system for suburban cases; and

WHEREAS, the new system will at least double the number of appearances required by the city prosecutor; and

WHEREAS, the City of Falcon Heights does not have the funds to provide for the staffing of the new system given the current economic conditions.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT PROCLAIMED that the City of Falcon Heights requests that the Ramsey County District Court retain the current scheduling system for suburban criminal cases.
