WHEREAS, Deb Bloom has served as the City Engineer for the City of Falcon Heights for the past eight years; and

WHEREAS, she has been instrumental in a number of crucial construction projects including the major street reconstructions of Hamline, Hoyt, and Roselawn Avenues; and

WHEREAS, she worked closely with Capitol Region Watershed District to obtain cost-share funds for the Falcon Heights City Hall permeable pavement parking lot and rain garden; and

WHEREAS, she was a key component in the establishment of a Joint Powers Agreement between Falcon Heights and Roseville, ensuring that Falcon Heights had access to engineering and technical support services that were greatly needed but previously unattainable; and

WHEREAS, she played a key role in coordinating the efforts of Roseville, Gibbs Farm, and the University of Minnesota in order to apply for and obtain federal grant funds to establish the Northeast Suburban Campus Connector along Fairview, Larpenteur, and Gortner Avenues; and

WHEREAS, her hard work, dedication, and insight will be missed by the City Council, staff, and residents of Falcon Heights;
