Jan:

I am enclosing billing statements for the months of June, July and August 1987. You will notice a dramatic change in the form of the billing document. I am hopeful that this will provide the city with more useful information regarding prosecution services. There is a billing document for each prosecution and each document itemizes work done by various people within our firm by date.

I am requesting that the City of Falcon Heights prepare one check for the monthly total. I have highlighted in yellow the individual totals and have included a tape for the total of all individual prosecutions in a particular month. The prosecution bills for the month of June inadvertently contained information that had been billed in the month of May. Therefore, there are some corrections on the June billing statements.

Jim Phillips, an attorney, will be handling most of the court and pretrial appearances on traffic matters. I will appear in connection with ordinance violations, gross misdemeanors and jury trials.

Regina Walsh and Virginia Dippel are paralegals who have input on various investigative and trial preparation aspects of the prosecutions. Since June many of the things which I formerly did are now being done by paralegals. The attorney time is being billed at the rate of \$42.50 per hour. The paralegal time, is being billed at the rate of \$30.00 per hour. This has resulted in a savings to the city since June of 1987.

I am proposing that the hourly rates for attorneys be increased to \$55.00 per hour commencing December 1, 1987. I believe the increased attorney rate will be offset by the fact that paralegals can do a fair amount of work at a lesser hourly rate. I would be happy to discuss this matter with you and/or the city council at your convenience.
