SUMMARY AND ACTION REQUESTED: As part of its Consent Agenda, the City Council is asked to approve disbursements and payroll in the amount of \$ 225,714.87. No specific motion is needed, as this is recommended to be part of the overall approval of the *Consent Agenda*.
