SUMMARY AND ACTION REQUESTED: The city council is being asked to receive an update from Washington County as a follow up to the June 12, 2007 Transportation Workshop as it relates the Lake Elmo Avenue/TH 36 intersection.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

Federal funds have been identified for the construction of an overpass at the intersection of Lake Elmo Avenue (CSAH 17) and Trunk Highway 36. At a follow up meeting after the June 12th Workshop, city staff and Washington County staff discussed the proposed improvements to this intersection. Washington County brought forth the idea of a developing a Design Review Committee for this project to determine what best meets Washington County/State/City needs but it is not finally approved. Washington County will give a presentation on the process and schedule for implementing this committee. The committee usually is made up of four representatives from each community of which 1 or 2 are council members.
