CITY OF LAKE ELMO CITY COUNCIL MINUTES AUGUST 8, 2018

CALL TO ORDER/PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE

Mayor Pearson called the meeting to order at 7:00 pm.

PRESENT: Mayor Mike Pearson and Councilmembers Julie Fliflet, Jill Lundgren and Christine Nelson.

Staff present: Administrator Handt, City Attorney Sonsalla, City Engineer Griffin, City Planner Prchal, Finance Director Iverson, Assistant City Administrator Foster, Public Works Director Weldon, Fire Chief Malmquist, and City Clerk Johnson.

APPROVAL OF AGENDA

Item 8, "Approve Snowmobile Ordinance" and item 7, "Approve Chicken Ordinance Update" were moved to the Regular Agenda. Item 19, "Tree Preservation Ordinance Amendments" was postponed to a workshop.

Mayor Pearson, seconded by Councilmember Fliflet moved TO APPROVE THE AGENDA AS AMENDED. Motion passed 4-0.

ACCEPT MINUTES

Minutes of the July 17, 2017 Special Meeting were accepted as presented.

PUBLIC COMMENTS/INQUIRIES

Virginia Pleban, 8245 59th Street North, encouraged the public to vote in the upcoming Primary Election.

PRESENTATIONS

Lake Elmo Jaycees President Mike Slobodnik and Charitable Gambling Manager Emily Goldhammer presented the City a donation of \$10,000 for purchase of replacement equipment for the Lake Elmo Fire Department.

Councilmember Fliflet, seconded by Councilmember Lundgren, moved TO ADOPT RESOLUTION 2018-086 ACCEPTING A DONATION FROM THE LAKE ELMO JAYCEES.

Councilmember Lundgren, seconded by Councilmember Nelson, moved TO APPROVE THE CONSENT AGENDA AS PRESENTED. Motion passed 5 - 0.

ITEM 12: Wellhead Protection Plan Part 2

Public Works Director Weldon provided a brief overview of the Wellhead Protection Plan.

Councilmember Lundgren, seconded by Councilmember Fliflet, moved TO APPROVE THE WELLHEAD PROTECTION PLAN PART 2. Motion passed 4-0.

ITEM 13: Presentation and Acceptance of 2017 Comprehensive Annual Financial Report

Jason Miller, Smith Schafer and Associates, presented a report on the 2017 Audit and 2017 CAFR.

ITEM 14: Purchase of Generator and Updates to Tower 1

Public Works Director Weldon presented information regarding purchase of a generator for well #2 and installation of a hydrant and gate valves at water tower #1 to allow tower #1 to be able to be put back into service after the shut down of well #1.

Councilmember Lundgren, seconded by Councilmember Fliflet, MOVED TO APPROVE THE PURCHASE OF GENERATOR THROUGH MIDWEST ELECTRIC AND GENERATOR AND INSTALLATION OF HYDRANT AND GATE VALVES BY CAPRA'S UTILITIES FOR AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$68,000 WITH FULL REIMBURSEMENT PROVIDED BY MINNESOTA POLLUTION CONTROL AGENCY. Motion passed 4 – 0.

ITEM 15: Demontreville Park Improvements

Public Works Director Weldon presented quotes for proposed improvements to the baseball field at Demontreville Park. Discussion was held concerning potential contributions from Mahtomedi Baseball for the improvements. Weldon indicated that he had not received interest in cost participation from Mahtomedi Baseball.

Councilmember Lundgren moved TO APPROVE AND AWARD QUOTE FOR DEMONTREVILLE PARK BASEBALL FIELD IMPROVEMENTS TO PEMBER COMPANIES FOR AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$70,000. Motion died – no second.

ITEM 16: Legacy at Northstar 1st Addition Final Plat

City Planner Prchal presented the proposal for approval of the final plat for the proposed Legacy at North Star development. Planner Prchal also reviewed engineering comments, proposed conditions of approval and Planning Commission comments.

Josh Peltier, 4017 Kirkwood Lane N., expressed concerns regarding perimeter buffers.

Joe Chavez, 3505 Kelvin Ave. N., expressed concern about buffers on future development.

Zak Edstrom, 4155 Kirkwood Lane N., asked for reconsideration of the buffers and expressed concern regarding the development process.

Rande Gosso, 4132 Kirkwood Lane N., commented on the development process.

Richard Mathis, 4265 Kirkwood Lane N., expressed support for his neighbors.

Tim Narum, 3960 Kindred Way, stated that his neighborhood needs to connect to the city sewer system and the proposed development will bring the sewer lines to them so they are hoping to start the process soon.

Mayor Pearson moved TO TABLE THE CURRENT ITEM TO THE NEXT MEETING.

Motion died – no second.

Councilmember Lundgren, seconded by Councilmember Fliflet, moved TO ADOPT ORD. 08-218 APPROVING THE REQUEST FOR A ZONING MAP AMENDMENT TO REZONE PID#S 11.029.21.43.0001 AND 11.029.21.44.0001 AS SHOWN ON THE LOT LINE ADJUSTMENT EXHIBIT DATED APRIL 20, 2018. Motion passed 4 – 0.

Mayor Pearson, seconded by Councilmember Nelson, moved TO ADOPT RESOLUTION 2018-090 APPROVING THE LEGACY AT NORTH STAR 1ST ADDITION FINAL PLAT AND PUD PLANS WITH RECOMMENDED FINDINGS AND CONDITIONS OF APPROVAL.

Councilmember Fliflet, seconded by Councilmember Lundgren, moved TO AMEND THE PRIMARY MOTION TO ADD A CONDITION STATING THAT ALL SIGNIFICANT TREES REMOVED BY THE APPLICANT WILL BE REPLACED IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE LANDSCAPING PLANS. Motion passed 4 – 0.

Councilmember Fliflet, seconded by Councilmember Lundgren, moved TO AMEND THE PRIMARY MOTION TO ADD A CONDITION REQUIRING A 100 FOOT MINIMUM LOT LINE BUFFER FROM THE ADJACENT DEVELOPMENT TO PRESERVE THE GREEN BELT CORRIDOR. Motion failed 2 – 2. (Pearson, Nelson – nay)

Primary motion failed 2-2. (Fliflet, Lundgren – nay)

City Attorney Sonsalla noted that the plat will automatically be approved after 60 days per state statute as preliminary approval has already been issued.

ITEM 17: Legacy at Northstar 1st Addition Developers Agreement

Councilmember Fliflet, seconded by Councilmember Lundgren, moved TO TABLE ITEM 17. Motion passed 4-0.

ITEM 18: Home Occupation Ordinance Amendments

City Planner Prchal presented the proposed amendments to the home occupation ordinance to add standards to the code.

Councilmember Lundgren, seconded by Councilmember Fliflet, moved TO ADOPT ORDINANCE 08-219 WHICH ESTABLISHES REGULATORY LANGUAGE FOR HOME OCCUPATIONS. Motion passed 4 – 0.

Councilmember Lundgren, seconded by Councilmember Fliflet, moved TO ADOPT RESOLUTION 2018-091 AUTHORIZING SUMMARY PUBLICATION OF ORDINANCE 08-219. Motion passed 4-0.

ITEM 7: Chicken Ordinance Update

Councilmember Nelson, seconded by Mayor Pearson, moved TO POSTPONE ITEM 7. Motion passed 4-0.

ITEM 8: Snowmobile Ordinance Update

City Planner Prchal provided a brief overview of the proposed updates to the snowmobile ordinance.

Councilmember Lundgren, seconded by Mayor Pearson, moved TO ADOPT ORDINANCE 08-217. Motion passed 3 – 1. (Fliflet – nay)



ISSUE BEFORE COUNCIL: Should the City Council reject bids for the 2018 Mill and Overlay Project?

BACKGROUND: Each year the City implements preventive maintenance work on the public streets consisting of minor reconstruction and subgrade correction, resurfacing, mill and overlays, crack sealing, seal coating, and patching. The annual Preventive Street Maintenance Program employs a cost effective approach for street repairs to extend the life expectancy of the pavements. Streets selected for the Preventive Street Maintenance Program are determined by using a pavement management system where each street pavement in the City is assigned a condition rating based on visual inspection of the pavement distresses and observed deterioration. The number of streets selected each year is dependent upon the amount of funding available for the program. Streets that have exceeded their life expectancy and can no longer be effectively maintained are programed for reconstruction in the City's Capital Improvement Program.

For 2018, the following streets were identified for mill and overlay improvements:

- Iris Avenue N from CSAH 14 to 37th Street North, including 450 feet of full depth patching.
- 37th Street N from Iris Avenue N to Ironwood Trail N.
- Ironwood Trail N from 35th Street N to 37th Street N, including 65 feet of full depth patching.
- 35th Street N from Iris Avenue N to Ironwood Trail N, including 785 feet of full depth patching.

A "mill & overlay" is a street maintenance technique that requires the removal of the top pavement layer of the street by the grinding action of a large milling machine. After the top layer is removed, a new layer of bituminous pavement is placed. Prior to the mill and overlay, localized areas with significant distress and potential subgrade failure are corrected by completing a full depth patch (removal and replacement of the entire aggregate base and pavement layers). The mill and overlay will remove the surface distresses, improve ride quality, and will preserve the lower portion of the pavement. Cracks that extend the full depth of the pavement are likely to reflect into the new pavement within two years of construction.

PROPOSAL DETAILS/ANALYSIS: Bids were received, publicly opened, and read aloud on Monday, August 6th, 2018. A Tabulation of Bids and a letter of recommendation for the rejection of the bids has been prepared and attached. The City received 4 bids for this project, with North Valley, Inc. providing the lowest bid in the amount of \$319,385.95, which is approximately \$33,000 over the engineer's estimate.

Staff is recommending that the City Council reject the bids as outlined in the attached letter. Staff feels that contractors are extremely busy this year and were not able to accommodate the City's schedule without increasing their unit prices. Staff's intent is to rebid the project together with the 2019 Mill and Overlay

Project hoping to obtain lower unit pricing with a larger scale project and bid earlier in the year. The Project was advertised on QuestCDN.com and in the Oakdale-Lake Elmo Review in accordance with the Minnesota Competitive Bidding requirements.

FISCAL IMPACT: None.

RECOMMENDATION: Staff is recommending that the City Council approve, *as part of the Consent Agenda*, Resolution No. 2018-095, rejecting bids for the 2018 Mill and Overlay Project. If removed from the consent agenda, the recommended motion for the action is as follows:

"Move to approve Resolution No. 2018–095, rejecting bids for the 2018 Mill and Overlay Project."

BACKGROUND: The City of Lake Elmo Public Works Department uses a wide array of vehicles to delivery daily and essential services to its residents. To accomplish daily tasks, the department utilizes 8 vehicles for its full and part-time staff to achieve daily and emergency tasks. With the growth of the community and increase in daily workloads and services, the department is having trouble in delivery of daily requirements with its existing fleet of vehicles, and at times personal vehicles are used to conduct city business.

Included in the 2018 Capital Improvement Plan is the purchase of a new (additional) pickup to be utilized by the water and sewer utilities along with the replacement of a 2003 1-ton truck utilized for street work.

<u>ISSUE BEFORE COUNCIL:</u> Does the City Council approve the purchase of these new trucks as recommended by the Maintenance Advisory Committee?

PROPOSAL DETAILS/ANALYSIS: With the approval to purchase these two vehicles, the following will be achieved:

- A new ¾ ton Pickup truck will fill the gap for vehicles that are needed to keep up with the growth based demand of water and sewer utility work. This vehicle will be equipped with equipment and tools that are needed on a daily basis as well as some common emergency supplies.
- Replacement of the existing 2003 Ford 1-ton with a similar vehicle will eliminate costly repairs
 which are on the horizon for the existing vehicle. Two new options being considered for the new
 1-ton are the addition of calibrated sanding equipment and anit-icing equipment to treat roads prior
 to snow falls.

FISCAL IMPACT: Total cost for both vehicles will be an amount not to exceed \$110,000. Funding for the proposed purchases will be through the Capital Outlay portion of the adopted 2018 Budget.

- Chevy 2500 ³/₄ ton \$40,000 (includes toolboxes and warning lights)
- Ford F-450 1-ton \$70,000 less grant of 4,327 = 65,673

It should be noted that in April 2018, Public Works applied for and was awarded a grant for reimbursement of 50% for the cost of anti-icing equipment included as part of the 1-ton purchase. An amount of \$4,327

will be reimbursed to the city by South Washington Watershed District upon completed installation and delivery of the anti-icing equipment.

OPTIONS:

- Approve the purchase of two (2) trucks
- Deny the purchase of two (2) trucks
- Amend truck purchase and approve.

RECOMMENDATION:

"Motion to approve the purchase of a ¾ ton pickup from Ranger GM and 1-ton truck from Midway Ford outfitted by Towmaster Equipment through the State of Minnesota Cooperative Purchasing for an amount not to exceed \$110,000 for both vehicles"

AGENDA ITEM: Well #2 Programmable Logic Controller (PLC) Replacement

REVIEWED BY: Kristina Handt, City Administrator

BACKGROUND: Since construction in 2003 nearly all mechanical and electrical equipment in Well #2 is original and reaching a point of repair and/or replacement. One such and very critical electrical component that has reached this threshold is the Programmable Logic Controller or PLC. The PLC is the "brain" of the well. Nearly all critical controlling for the well to operated and communicate with the SCADA master control computer is done through the PLC. On June 28th and 29th of 2018 there were intermittent failures of this PLC in which all communication was lost between Well #2 and SCADA Control at Public Works. During this time, all automatic controls were lost between these sites and manual operation needed to be conducted.

Telemetry Process and Controls, the City's control integrator, determined that the PLC is in need of replacement. Due to age and technology advancements, the existing PLC is difficult to find parts for and is no longer supported by its manufacture. To ensure technology advancements are met it is recommended to replace the existing PLC with a new one that will support current and future activities at Well #2

ISSUE BEFORE COUNCIL: Should the City Council approve replacement of the PLC in Well #2?

PROPOSAL DETAILS/ANALYSIS: By replacing the PLC in Well #2 the city strengthens its commitment to deliver an uninterrupted water supply to its consumers. In addition, replacement of a 15-year-old electrical component will allow better flexibility for future improvements as need at the well in the coming years.

FISCAL IMPACT: Cost of the replacement, installation, programming and 1-year warranty is \$10,331.00 and will be funded through the Water Utility Repair and Improvements portion of the General Budget.

We shall not be responsible for materials damaged, lost or stolen after delivery, through no fault of ours, or for failure to deliver and perform because of reasons beyond our control.

EXCLUSIVE REMEDIES: Remedies are limited to the repair or replacement at FOB point of delivery. Consequential damages are excluded. In no event shall TPC be responsible for consequential damages of any such defective material or workmanship including, but not limited to, the Purchaser's loss of material or profits, increased expenses of operation, downtime or reconstruction of the work, and in no event shall TPC's obligation under this warranty exceed the original contract price of the defective item. It is agreed that any action for breach of express or implied warranty shall be initiated within fifteen (15) months of the date of shipment by TPC and only those defects that are documented to have occurred within twelve (12) months from the date of the equipment's start-up and acceptance or (15) months from the date of TPC's shipment, whichever happens first, will be covered by the warranty.

DISCLAIMER: TPC will not be responsible for damage to equipment or materials through improper installation, storage, improper services, or through attempts to operate it in excess of its rated capacity or recommended use, intentional or otherwise, by parties other than TPC or its authorized representatives.

The remedies set forth herein are exclusive, and the total cumulative liability of seller and it suppliers under any purchase order or any act or omission in connection therewith or related thereto, whether in contract, in tort (including negligence and strict liability), under any warranty, or otherwise, will be limited to the price of the contract.

B. The provisions of this Article shall survive termination, cancellation or expiration of the purchase order and shall apply, notwithstanding any other provisions of this Agreement or any related document thereto, to the fullest extent permitted by law. Prior to the transfer of any equipment or material furnished or for which work is furnished hereunder from the project site (except temporarily for repair work or permanently for disposal), or the transfer of any interest therein or in the plant, Purchaser shall obtain for Seller written assurances from the transferee of limitation of and protection against liability following the proposed transfer at least equivalent to that afforded seller and its suppliers under the purchase order.

AGENDA ITEM: Rescission of Vote on Legacy at Northstar Final Plat

BACKGROUND:

At the August 8, 2018 City Council meeting, a motion was made to approve the final plat and PUD for Legacy at Northstar (Resolution No 2018-090). With only four members in attendance the motion was not approved on a 2-2 vote.

Council Member Bloyer was absent from the August 8, 2018 meeting. He has informed staff he would like to rescind the vote from the August 8th meeting so that he has an opportunity to vote on the resolution. Notice has been provided by placing this item on the agenda.

ISSUE BEFORE COUNCIL:

Should the Council approve a motion to rescind the vote on the Legacy at Northstar Final Plat and PUD from the August 8, 2018 meeting?

PROPOSAL:

Council Member Bloyer will be introducing a motion at the August 21, 2018 City Council meeting to rescind the City Council's decision on August 8, 2018 regarding Resolution No. 2018-090. Should that motion be approved, the Council's decision will be rescinded and there will be no decision regarding this item. Assuming the decision is rescinded, the Council will need to consider whether to approve the resolution approving the Legacy at North Star 1st Addition Final Plat and Planned Unit Development (PUD) Plans.
