AGENDA ITEM: Reconsideration of Council Vote on Administrator's Contract Negotiations

BACKGROUND:

At the February 19, 2019 Council meeting, the Council voted to direct the City Attorney to negotiate a new contract with the City Administrator to be brought back for the Council's consideration.

Council Member Bloyer voted on the prevailing side but has since requested that the vote be reconsidered.
