WASHINGTON COLUMN, MINNESOTA ORDINANCE ANENOMO SECTION 1942-220 OF THE 1975 LAKE ELMO MUNICIPAL COME AS IT BELATER TO THE CO.

SECTION 1. Admittability: Section 1402.020 of the 1979 Municipal Code of the City of Lake Elmo is, hereby amended to change the date or the terminal licerating of dogs in the City of Lake Elmo, and Section 1402.020 will read as follows:
1402.020 Dog Licerating Requiring: No person shall own, keep or harbor any dog over the age of four months, within the City of Lake Elmo, unless a dog licerase therefor has first been secured. Dog Liceratine shall be issued by the Administrator for a fee set by Reselfution of the City Council, it shall be the duty of each person owning, keeping, or harboring at dog to pay the licerase fee imposed by this Section to the Administrator on or before the Section to the Administrator on or before the Section to the Administrator on or before the first dity of Jensery each year, or upon suitable, recitioned in the City.
