- **Subd. 3. New Street Name.** The term new street name shall mean the name by which a street shall be known from and after the effective date of this ordinance.
- **SECTION 3.** The Existing Street Name of Stillwater Boulevard shall have a New Street Name of Stillwater Way N.
- **SECTION 4.** The adjustment shall not affect the entire length of Stillwater Boulevard. The section which will be renamed is further described as North of the realigned Stillwater Boulevard/CSAH 14 and West of the realigned Stillwater Boulevard/CSAH 15 and is shown in Exhibit A.
- **SECTION 5.** Effective Date. This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon adoption and publication in the official newspaper of the City of Lake Elmo.
- **SECTION 6.** Adoption Date. This Ordinance 08-219 was adopted on this 2nd day of January 2019, by a vote of 3 Ayes and Nays.
