ISSUE BEFORE COUNCIL: Should the City Council approve the Plans and Specifications and Order the Advertisement for the 2023 Trail Improvements?

BACKGROUND: On June 21, 2022, the City Council authorized engineering services and preparation of the plans and specifications for the 2022 Trail Improvements. The project was initiated as part of the 2022 Parks Commission work plan, approved on May 3, 2022. During detailed design, staff recommended that the project be deferred to 2023 construction to allow for the acquisition of easements that would be needed to construct the improvements. The Project was amended in February, 2023 to combine the Park Commission work plan trail segments for 2022 and 2023 as one project, renamed as the "2023 Trail Improvements."

The project includes approximately 7,260 feet of new trail segments, paving existing gravel trail segments, and reconstruction of existing paved trails. Trail segments include Stonegate neighborhood trails (Trail A, Trail B, Trail C and Trail D); the Hamlet on Sunfish Lake to Tapestry trail connection; the "City Walking Path"; the Sunfish Ponds Walking Trails; and the DeMontreville Wildlife Area Walking Path. Trail construction or reconstruction will consist of common excavation and grading, installation of an aggregate base, pavement, and pedestrian ramp installation in accordance with the City Engineering Design Standards.

PROPOSAL DETAILS/ANALYSIS: The plans and specifications have been completed for the improvements and are ready to be advertised for contractor bids. A bid date has been scheduled for May 25, 2023. Once received, bids will be reviewed by staff with results to be presented to council on June 6, 2023 to consider awarding a construction contract.

FISCAL IMPACT: The project will be funded through the City's park funds and will not be assessed to benefitting properties. Approval of this motion does not commit the council to the project costs. Once contractor bids are received, the actual construction costs will be known and the council will be asked to consider entering into a contract to complete the work.

RECOMMENDATION: Staff is recommending that the City Council consider approving, as part of the consent agenda, a Resolution approving the plans and specifications and ordering the advertisement for bids for the 2023 Trail Improvements. If removed from the consent agenda, the recommended motion for this action is as follows:

"Move to approve Resolution No. 2023-042, approving the Plans and Specifications and Ordering the Advertisement for Bids for the 2023 Trail Improvements."

WHEREAS, pursuant to City Council resolution, adopted on June 21, 2022, the City Engineer, together with TKDA, Inc., has prepared plans and specifications for 2023 Trail Improvements and has presented such plans and specifications to the Council for approval.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED,

- 1. Such plans and specifications, a copy of which is on file at Lake Elmo City Hall, and made a part hereof, are hereby approved.
- 2. The City Clerk shall prepare and cause to be inserted in the official paper and posted online with Quest Construction Data Network (QuestCDN.com) an advertisement for bids upon the making of such improvements under such approved plans and specifications. The advertisement shall be published for at least 21 days, shall specify the work to be done, and shall state that sealed bids provided by following required electronic bidding procedures outlined by QuestCDN prior to the specified bid date and time and accompanied by a bid bond or cashier's check made payable to the City of Lake Elmo in an amount not less than 5% of the amount of such bid will be considered.

Bids must be submitted electronically through QuestCDN no later than the date and time noted above, on the Proposal Forms provided in accordance with the Contract Documents, Plans, and Specifications as prepared by TKDA, Inc., which are on file for inspection in the office of the City Clerk and City Engineer. For this project, the City will only be accepting online electronic bids through QuestCDN.

To access the electronic bid form, download the project document and click the bidding button at the top of the advertisement.

For this project, bids will ONLY be received electronically. Contractors submitting an electronic bid will be charged an additional \$30 at the time of bid submission via the online electronic bid service QuestCDN.com. To access the electronic Bid Worksheet, download the project document and click the bidding button at the top of the advertisement. Prospective bidders must be on the plan holders list through QuestCDN for bids to be accepted. Bids shall be completed according to the Bidding Requirements prepared by TKDA dated May 2, 2023.

A Bid shall be submitted online no later than the date and time prescribed. For this project the City will only be accepting online electronic bids through Quest CDN. Prospective bidders must be on the planholders list through QuestCDN for bids to be accepted. Bids will only be accepted from Contractors who purchase Bidding Documents as specified above.

No bid will be considered unless submitted online prior to the time noted above for the closing of the bids, and accompanied by a bid bond in an amount not less than five percent (5%) of the total bid as a guarantee that the bidder, if successful, will enter into a contract with the City to perform the work described in the proposal. This deposit will be subject to forfeiture as provided by law. The deposits for the three lowest bidders will be retained by the City until the contract has been awarded and executed but not longer than sixty (60) days. No bid may be withdrawn for a period of sixty (60) days following the bid opening.

The City reserves the right to reject any or all bids, to waive informalities or to award the contract to the lowest responsible bidder, in the best interest of the City. For Bids exceeding \$50,000, the Bidder shall submit to the City a signed statement under oath by an owner or officer verifying compliance with each of the minimum criteria in Minnesota Statutes, section 16C.285, subdivision 3 on the Responsible Contractor Verification Form included with the Bid Proposal.
