ORDINANCE 9759

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 150 ADDING DEFINTIONS RELATED TO LOW IMAPCT AG USE

<u>Section 1. Amendment</u>: The 1997 Lake Elmo Municipal Code is hereby amended by adding the following definitions to Section 150.

SMALL ENGINE REPAIR: The tune-up, winterizing, rebuilding, and general repair of internal combustion engines of 24 rated horsepower or less; together with repairs and replacement of mechanical components of the machines or tools powered by such engines. Including, but not limited to lawn mowers, snow blowers, garden tillers, chain saws, and pumps. Specifically excluding snowmobiles, ATV's, motorcycles, and personal watercraft. Retail or wholesale sales of any product are specifically excluded.

AGRICULTURAL MUSEUMS: The keeping, restoration, maintenance and display of the structures, tools and equipment utilized in the production of agricultural products. Restoration and maintenance activity shall be limited to those structures, tools, and equipment permanently kept on display on the premises. Retail or wholesale sales of any product are specifically excluded.

<u>NATURE FARMS</u>: The keeping of animals and/or the growing and keeping of agricultural products for the purpose of display to the public, not including the breeding and keeping of animals for boarding or sale. Examples of this use would include "petting farms", or the display of unique horticulture. Retail or wholesale sales of any product are specifically excluded.

<u>Section 2. EFFECTIVE DATE</u>: This ordinance shall be effective upon its passage and publication according to law.

<u>ADOPTION DATE</u>: Passed by the City Council of the City of Lake Elmo the 15th day of August, 2000.
