## CITY OF LAKE ELMO WASHINGTON COUNTY, MINNESOTA ORDINANCE 8086

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTIONS 212.012, 212.013 AND 212.027 OF THE LAKE ELMO MUNICIPAL CODE AS IT RELATES TO THE HERITAGE PRESERVATION COMMISSION

AMENDMENT: The City Council ordains that Sections 212.012, 212.013 and 212.027 of the Lake Elmo Municipal Code shall be amended to read as follows:

212.012 <u>COMPOSITION:</u> The Heritage Preservation Commission (H.P.C.) shall consist of five (5) members, two alternate members, and shall include, if available, a member of the Washington County Historical Society.

212.013 <u>OUALIFICATIONS:</u> Each commission member must be a person with demonstrated interest and expertise in historic preservation and must reside within the City of Lake Elmo with the exception of ex-officio members.

212.027 <u>POWERS:</u> To actively promote historical preservation within the City. To establish and maintain liaison with civic, church, and other groups for the purpose of promoting historic preservation. To promote gifting of structures, or money to promote the activities involved in historical preservation.
